And this year we will go back to not offering a choice of Section. Each stalk fits in one and only one Section.

NOT TALL BEARDED

If your iris is anything other than a Tall Bearded, you must enter it in its general classification

TALL BEARDED

If your iris is Tall Bearded, then there are 4 possible Sections, and the following rules will tell you which is the one and only section you may enter it in

- 1 Was it introduced before 1996?
 - 1A If yes, then your only option is Historic TB Section HIST
 - 1B If no, continue to step 2
- 2 Does your non-historic iris have the horns, spoons or flounces of a Space Age Iris?
 - 2A If yes then your only option is Space Age TB Section SATB
 - 2B If no, continue to step 3
- 3 Does your non-historic, non-space age iris have other novelty characteristics, like broken color or a flat form?

3A - If yes then your only option is Other Novelty TB - Section ONTB

- 3B If no, continue to step 4
- 4 If you get to this step then your iris must be introduced 1996 or later, is not a space age iris, and does not have any other novelty characteristics. Correct?
 - 4A If correct then your only option is Other TB Section TB
 - 4B If no, you messed up somewhere, start again!

Historic?

Check and note the year of Introduction to Commerce, not the year of Registration, to determine if your Variety is Historic. In the example on the right, it is the year highlighted yellow next to the garden that first sold the Variety, NOT the date next to the "R" just after the Name and Hybridizer...
