## NOT TALL BEADED

If your iris is anything other than a Tall Bearded, you must enter it in its general classification in Sections E – R. Sections A – D are for Tall Bearded Iris ONLY

## TALL BEARDED

If your iris is Tall Bearded, then there are 4 possible Sections, and the following rules will tell you which is the one and only section you may enter it in

- 1 Was it introduced before 1988?
  - 1A If yes, then your only option is Historic TB Section D
  - 1B If no, continue to step 2
- 2 Does your non-historic iris have the horns, spoons or flounces of a Space Age Iris?
  - 2A If yes then your only option is Space Age TB Section B
  - 2B If no, continue to step 3
- 3 Does your non-historic, non-space age iris have other novelty characteristics, like broken color or a flat form?
  - 3A If yes then your only option is Other Novelty TB Section C
  - 3B If no, continue to step 4
- 4 If you get to this step then your iris must be introduced 1988 or later, is not a space age iris, and does not have any other novelty characteristics. Correct?
  - 4A If correct then your only option is Other TB Section A
  - 4B If no, you messed up somewhere, start again!
